Florida's Voluntary Prekindergarten Program

Register Now! It's easy as 1, 2, 3 . . .

1. **Fill out the application.** You may call and request an application by mail, fill one out online, or complete the application at the registration site. Your child will not officially be enrolled until you register in person. If you choose to fill out the application online or by mail, please bring the application with you to registration.
2. **Register in person.** Bring proof of your physical address and proof of your child's age to any intake site location. These locations include any Coordinated Child Care office, or stop by one of our many remote locations throughout Pinellas County. Call 547-5782 or visit our website to find an intake site near you. Evening and weekend hours are available!
3. **Choose a VPK site that meets your needs.** To formally enroll, present the Certificate of Eligibility, which you received when you registered, to your provider.
